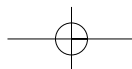

FIELD HOUSE - General Conditions for All Shows

1. It is a Condition of ENTRY that all competitors have READ and **AGREED** to abide by all the rules and have filled in the official Entry Form. Entries accepted at rider's own risk. BSJA & BD Rules apply.
2. It is deemed a condition of entry that neither the organisers, nor any agent, employee or representative accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grooms, spectators or any person whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way, and each entrant shall indemnify the promoter against any legal action. All persons attend at their own risk and are responsible for their own actions.
3. HEALTH & SAFETY. The organiser has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective EVERYONE must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey officials and stewards.
4. BSJA Rule 82.81. No rider shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible to compete or be prepared to compete in any S/J class without taking adequate precautions to ensure safety of the riders or grooms.
5. **Horses must NOT be left unattended at any time, unless inside a secure horse box, Tying and leaving outside boxes is not permitted. Haynets NOT to be fed outside horse box.**
MUCKING OUT IN LORRY PARK IS PROHIBITED. PLEASE TAKE LITTER HOME.
6. **Riders and 1 groom only in the Collecting & Warming Up Areas. Horses/ponies may only be ridden in these areas if they are pre-entered and are competing in the class in progress.**
Any horse/pony being held must be behind barrier in designated area.
7. Spectators and children **NOT ALLOWED** in warm-up or collecting area.
8. No unsupervised children allowed on these premises. Parents will be held responsible for **ALL** children brought to the Show and will be asked to remove all unruly children from the premises and pay for any damage they may have caused.
9. No person will be allowed in the ring except Judges & Officials.
10. Practice Ring Fences to be jumped with Red Wing on the right, White Wing on the left. No lunging in Warm Up Area.
11. Show organisers reserve the right to cancel any event, amend or amalgamate any class and refuse any entry.
12. Judges decision is **FINAL**.
13. BSJA or BD Rules for dress and saddlery apply, hats of the current standard must be worn at all times by anyone mounted, with the harness correctly adjusted and fastened.
14. Entries in Affiliated Jumping Classes are restricted to horses/ponies registered with the BSJA, and ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79, or riders with a ticket.
15. Any objection must be handed to Hon. Secretary in writing within 30 mins. of the event, with a deposit of £50, and if the objection is not sustained such deposit shall be forfeited.
16. No entry accepted without correct fee. All showjumping entries taken on the day.
Unaffiliated Shows - Juniors not to have attained their 16th Birthday by 1st Jan. the current year.
17. In the event of insufficient starters, lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6
18. PLEASE USE LITTER BINS PROVIDED, or take your litter home.
19. NO REFUNDS. NO LUNGEING ON SHOWGROUND.
20. No bicycles or motor cycles allowed on the Showground. No dogs allowed in the Gallery or the Arena. **NO SMOKING.**

22. DOGS - On leads, but not in Gallery or Arenas.

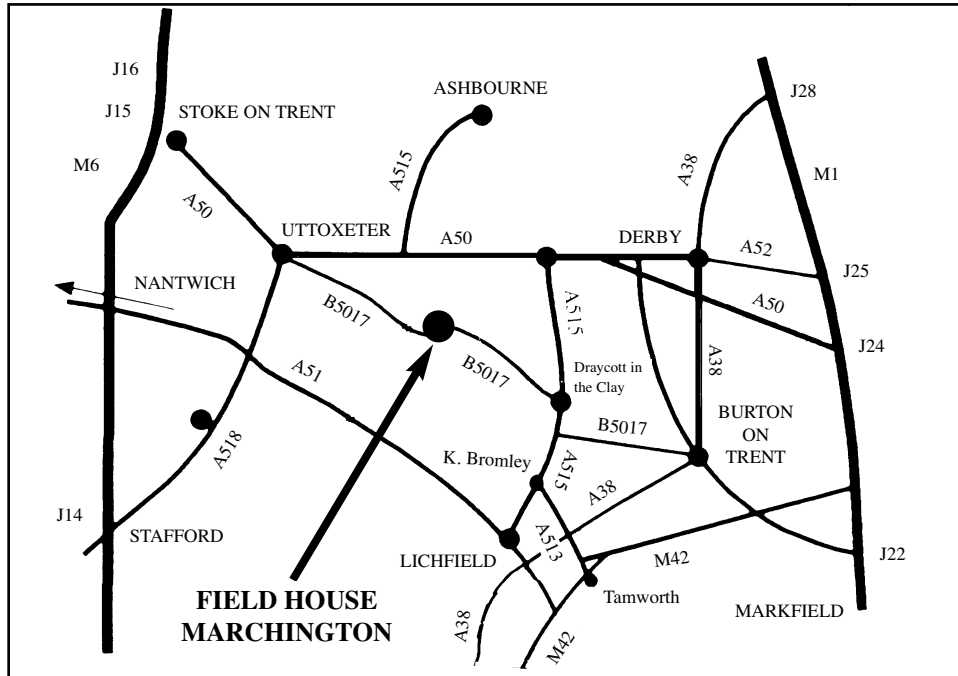
